The stipulation will be So Ordered and e-filed by the court.

The calendar will be held each **Monday**, in **courtroom 314**. There will be three (3) <u>separate</u> calendar calls at **9:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 2:15 p.m.** Each calendar will be presided over by a Judge and/or a Court Attorney-Referee. The Court Attorney-Referee will have the authority to So Order stipulations entered into by the parties.

Attorneys and self-represented litigants **MUST APPEAR IN-PERSON**. The conferences will <u>not</u> be held virtually.

Parties on cases scheduled for a conference in the Non-Compliance Part will be notified of the date and time of the conference, in advance of the scheduled conference, **through eCourts**.
